The Morojwa and Morula Rooms seat 100 people each, the Motswere Room seat 150 and the Mowana room 300. The entertainment area with a pool-side pub and band stand accommodates up to 500 guests for corporate functions, weddings, braais, and tailor made dinners and other festivities.

The hotel presently boasts 80 delightful rooms, all tastefully decorated in rustic African theme. All rooms boast seven channel digital satellite television, fully air conditioned telephone and tea and coffee making facilities.

The Mophane Grill offers mouth watering cuisine inspired by many flavours of Africa. The lunch and dinner menu is a wonderful assortment of "home cooked" style meals all ready to tantalize your taste buds. You can relax at the terrace where light meals are served or take a sundowner in the cocktail bar or pool bar.

The hotel also has a fully serviced camping site with hot showers. Both the camping and caravan sites are supervised and secure, allowing you to enjoy your stay.

Inception of Lodge

Tati River Lodge began operation in May 1999, 16 standard rooms to offer, the reception plus the administration block and by December 2000 a 120 seater restaurant had been constructed with a terrace, cocktail bar, campsite and caravan car park with ablutions, swimming and paddling pools, 24 rooms comprised of: 4 bed suites with en suite bathrooms and kitchenette, 4 studios with en suite bathrooms and kitchenette, 4 roundavels and laundry room.



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In March 2001 an official opening by His Excellency President F.G Mogae boosted marketing initiatives by playing a role in getting continuous support from various government departments.

At the end of 2001 the lodge expanded to a total of 49 rooms. To date the lodge stands at 80 rooms, being 26 executive rooms, 42 standard rooms, 4 studios, 4 bed suites, 1 presidential suite and 3 junior suites.

The lodge also boasts 4 conference rooms such as Morula and Morojwa with a capacity of 60 to 100 people, Motswere sits 100 to 150 people while Mowana takes 300 to 500 people.

Botswana has a well-developed road network with easy access to its neighboring countries. The vast majority of the roads are tarmac. Francistown is about 650 km away from Gauteng and can be easily accessed through Martins Drift Border Post.
